Orienteering Skills Clinic — 16 Oct 21

1. Orienteering is a specialized type of cross-country navigation. A regionally directed orienteering skills clinic will take place on 16 Oct 21 at Pinehurst Conservation Area (near Ayr).
2. Each cadet corps may register up to six (6) cadets (three (3) males and three (3) females) to participate in a clinic. Fewer cadets than the six (6) identified above may be selected to participate due to training limitations at a particular clinic. Prior experience or training in navigation is not required; the basics will be covered at this activity.
3. This is a parent drop-off activity; cadets are required to travel to Pinehurst by their own means. Participants are to arrive at the training location NLT 0830 hrs and should plan to depart for the home unit NLT 1700 hrs. Firm timings shall be passed on to all participants once selection to attend a clinic is confirmed.
4. Rations: Cadets are required to bring their own lunch and water.
5. Dress: Cadets are authorized to wear appropriate civilian clothing during this skills training. Running shoes shall be worn for the activity. Cadets are to ensure that they are dressed according to the weather conditions. Raingear and a change of clothing (including a second pair of shoes and socks) should be brought.
6. Public Health Measures: All measures will be followed. Provincial social distancing guidelines will be followed by all in attendance. Cadets and staff will wear proper personal protective equipment (PPE) during the entire activity.

7. Cadets interested in participating in this activity should email the undersigned at howard.scrimgeour@cadets.gc.ca promptly. As indicated above, places are limited; cadets will be given priority in the order received.
